- B. Emcees: Two people who will be Masters of Ceremony.
- C. DJ: One person responsible for the Music.
- D. Propmaster: One person for Lighting, Décor, and Props
- E. Models: All other members of the group.

- A. The show must be between 20 and 22 minutes long.
- Your group will host a fashion show and you are responsible for selecting a theme, choosing appropriate outfits, playing appropriate music, and describing each model as they walk the runway. You must use vocabulary learned both in Level I, and the current chapter.
  - Suggested themes include, but are not limited to: Under the Sea, Saharan Adventure, Halloween Horrors, Disney Dreams, A Day at Sandalwood, It's Party Time!, Let's Go on a Vacation, Seasonal Secrets, Decades (20's, 70's, 80's, etc.), Classic Books, and others. Be creative and original!
- B. Emcees
- The Emcees are responsible for conducting the fashion show from the first minute to the last. These people must be eloquent (well-spoken).
  - You must introduce each model as they walk down the runway. You may include their name and some personal or physical characteristics, but not what they're wearing. Hint: Mention something unique about the model, such as favorite color, favorite brand of clothing, favorite color, clothing and shoe size, etc. This is interesting to the judges!
  - Native Spanish-speaking students may NOT be Emcees.
- C. DJ
- The DJ is responsible for playing music and/or sound effects from the first minute to the last.
  - Inappropriate, obscene, or explicit music may not be used. If used, your group will receive zero points for this portion.
  - You may bring your own equipment, or, should you wish to use Alfonso's boombox, you may. It is equipped with an AUX cord.
- D. Propmaster
- The Propmaster is responsible for lighting, décor, and props.
  - Lighting: There are sockets available around the venue for lighting purposes.
  - Décor: You may decorate the venue during the five-minute prep time before the actual show.
  - Props: Your models may use props to enhance their walks. You are responsible for keeping track of these items.
- E. Models
- Each model must sport two different looks, and will walk two different times.
  - Your outfits must not violate Sandalwood's Dress Code.
  - You must incorporate a spoken line during walk that describes what you're wearing, where you bought the items and how you paid.
  - Each outfit must consist of at least a top, a bottom, and footwear.

  - ∴ Group Name
  - ∴ Theme
  - ∴ Approximate running time
  - ∴ Names of members, and their roles
  - ∴ Props and other décor items being used
  - ∴ Titles and artists of all music to be played
  - ∴ Description of each model's outfits
